

HOUSE-POOL PROTECTION DEVICE INSTALLATION

Residential Pool/Spa Permit Requirements City of Carrollton Building Inspection Department

The attached **Certification of House-Pool Protection Device Installation** form is utilized to assist homeowners and contractors in complying with the requirements of residential pool and/or spa permits.

By utilizing this form, the Building Inspection Department will require the code requirements for swimming pool/spa door protection. The homeowner accepts the responsibility of complying with the current Carrollton Construction Code regulations by his/her written documentation implemented by this form.

The following steps must be completed in order for the form to be accepted:

- 1. One of the two options must be initialed. If both devices are used on different doors, both options should be initialed.
- 2. The homeowner's name must be printed legibly on the appropriate line.
- 3. The site address must be printed legibly on the appropriate line.
- 4. A Notary must NOTARIZE the homeowner's signature.
- 5. The Notary must complete the final section of the document.
- 6. The form must be returned to Building Inspection Department at 1945 E. Jackson Road, Carrollton, TX 75006.
