# ORDINANCE NO. 3494

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 31, THE COMPREHENSIVE FEE SCHEDULE OF THE CARROLLTON CITY CODE; CONTAINING A SAVINGS CLAUSE, A REPEALING CLAUSE AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF OCTOBER 1, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS:

#### **SECTION 1**

That subsection (I) of Section 31.01, <u>Establishment of Fees for City Services</u>, of Title III, Administration, of the Carrollton Code of Ordinances is amended to read as follows:

## (I) Police.

#### (1) Definitions:

*Initial permit.* An initial permit is a alarm permit issued for a period of one year.

Renewal permit. A renewal permit is an alarm permit issued by the city before the expiration of an initial or renewal permit. The renewal permit effective date is the anniversary date of the prior permit. After expiration of a permit, it may not be renewed and a new initial permit must be obtained.

## (2) Permits:

Commercial alarm permits, per year: Initial permit	\$75.00 \$50.00
Residential alarm permits, per year: Initial permit	\$50.00 \$25.00
Alarm permit revocation appeal fee	\$25.00
Handbills, per six-month period	\$50.00
Solicitors, per six-month period	\$50.00

## (3) Alarm system false alarm fees:

False burglar alarm response charge based on number of false alarm responses in the previous 12 month period:

1 <sup>st</sup> to 3 <sup>rd</sup>	no charge
4 <sup>th</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup>	
6 <sup>th</sup> and 7 <sup>th</sup>	
8 <sup>th</sup> and more	

False alarm (other than burglar) response charge based on number of false alarm responses in the previous 12 month period:

1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup>	no charge
	\$100.00

## (4) Other fees:

Police reports, per report\$4.00
Police reports, per report certified (additional to original fee)\$1.00
Fingerprinting fee, per fingerprint card\$10.00
Accident Reports\$6.00
Clearance Letter\$4.00
Clearance Letter – Notarized\$5.00

## **SECTION 2**

That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent or in conflict with this Ordinance shall be and are hereby repealed.

## **SECTION 3**

That, save and except as amended by this Ordinance, all other Ordinances of the City of Carrollton, Texas shall remain in full force and effect.

## **SECTION 4**

That the provisions of this Ordinance are severable in accordance with Section 10.07 of the Code of Ordinance, City of Carrollton, Texas.

## **SECTION 5**

That this ordinance shall take effect from and after October 1, 2012.
