WHEREAS, the city of Carrollton has cultivated superior work standards as embodied in "The Carrollton Difference" that will provide for sustainable community development;

WHEREAS, the city of Carrollton believes firmly in responsible and strategic stewardship of its natural, human, material and commercial resources;

WHEREAS, the city of Carrollton desires to establish policies to achieve its fundamental belief of incorporating environmental responsibility into its daily management of urban and industrial growth, energy and water use, air and water quality, pollution prevention and waste reduction, economic development and historic preservation;

The city of Carrollton has therefore developed an Environmental Policy which reads as follows:

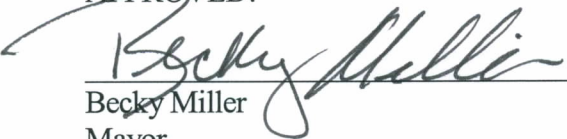

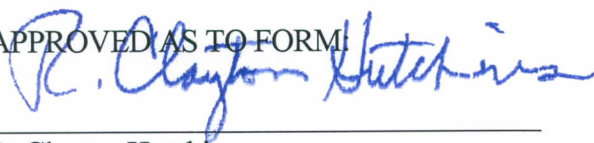

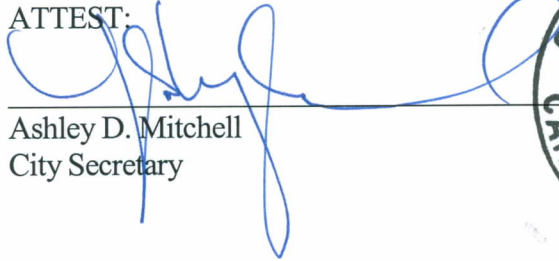
