

PROJECT SUMMARY SHEET:

Woodgate Neighborhood Association- Entryway Signs and Landscaping Improvements

Background:

The Woodgate Neighborhood is 21 years old and is represented by a voluntary neighborhood association. Woodgate currently has one neighborhood entry sign located off of Old Denton Road and they propose to install additional neighborhood signs at the Frankford Road entrances to the neighborhood.

Proposal:

Woodgate proposes erecting neighborhood gateway signs at their neighborhood entrances along Frankford Road. One type of sign will be mounted on a current screening wall, while the other type will be a freestanding monument sign. They also propose adding landscaping with the monument sign. Woodgate has discussed this proposal in neighborhood newsletters (5), quarterly meetings (5), and hand-delivered surveys. All of the feedback indicated that there was 100% approval of the project. The project contacts are Ms. Sandy May, 1111 Mackie, and Mr. Chris Rosipal, 2912 Redwood.

Budget/Materials/Labor:

The total budget for this project is \$14,012.84. Of this sum, the total grant request from the city is \$5,000, which equals 36% of the total grant request. Funding resources from Woodgate total \$6,802.84. Of Woodgate's contribution, residents have pledged \$955. The Woodgate association has committed \$5,847.84 of their funds. In addition, the neighborhood will provide for the future maintenance of the gateway landscaping and signs. Woodgate has also secured commitments for sweat equity labor and donated materials.

Neighborhood Advisory Commission Recommendations (NAC):

On June 8, 2000 the NAC heard presentations from the neighborhood associations regarding the Fall 2000 matching grant proposals. On July 13, 2000, the NAC discussed the proposals and voted on a recommendation. The Woodgate proposal was voted on by the NAC and was ***approved for recommendation with a vote of 8-0.***
