

ORDINANCE NO. 3330

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 31 OF THE CARROLLTON CODE OF ORDINANCES BY CREATING SECTION 31.01(T) TO THE COMPREHENSIVE FEE SCHEDULE, ADDING A SECTION TO CHAPTER 117 SPECIAL EVENTS FOR SALE AND CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT CITY SPONSORED EVENTS AND AMENDING SECTION 133.16(L) REGARDING THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON PARK PROPERTY; PROVIDING A SAVINGS AND SEVERABILITY CLAUSE, A PENALTY CLAUSE AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CARROLLTON, TEXAS:**

SECTION 1

Creating Section 31.01(T) of the Comprehensive Fee Schedule of the Carrollton City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

(T) The City shall not be required to pay any fee herein.

SECTION 2

Adding a section to Chapter 117, Special Events, for the Sale and Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages at City Sponsored Events and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Sale and Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages at City Sponsored Events

Section 117.37 Definition

*City Sponsored Events* shall mean any event that the City is a major sponsor and/or that is designated by the City Council.

Section 117.38 Restriction of the Sale and Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages

The sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages at City Sponsored Events is restricted and limited to the area that is approved by the Building Inspection Department as part of the permitting process. No person shall bring, carry or transport any alcoholic beverage into or onto any site in which a special event is taking place or where alcohol is sold.

Section 117.39 Sale and Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages on Park Property

The sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited at all times on park property except at City Sponsored Events and/or as allowed by the City Council or as provided in other sections of the Code.

SECTION 3

Amending Section 133.16 (L) Certain Activities Prohibited and is hereby amended to read as follows:

(L) To possess or consume any alcoholic beverage except as allowed on the municipal golf course or as referenced in Section 117 of the Code of Ordinance.

Section 4.

A violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be a misdemeanor and, upon conviction of such violation, such violation shall be punished by a penalty of fines as set forth in 10.99 for each offense.

Section 5.

That, save and except as amended by this ordinance, Title XIII, and Chapters 130 of the Carrollton City Code shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6.

That the provisions of this ordinance are severable in accordance with Section 10.07 of the Carrollton City Code.

Section 7.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are specifically repealed.

Section 8.

That this ordinance shall become effective from and after its passage and publication.
