# DISCUSSION OF UPDATED PARK MASTER PLAN

# PROJECT UPDATE FOR ROSEMEADE RECREATION CENTER

• Heather provided a presentation of what the Rosemeade Recreation Center expansion would look like. The bid award was presented and approved by the Council. Explained the project might take place starting around summer. The gym would be over 27 thousand square feet with a lot of new features such as extra storage, renovation to the restroom area and a new Esports Center. It is being planned to promote this project by posting the promotional video in different areas of the city and posters on boards around different locations.

- 22 trees were planted this Saturday, April 22 for Earth Day in four different parks around the city.
- Splash parks are opening on May 1<sup>st</sup> and the pool is opening on May 27<sup>th</sup>.
- We are working with Halff Associates to work on a TC Rice trail feasibility study. There will be the original trail that connects Lewisville towards Irving and part of that goes to TC Rice.
- We were approved by the Council to acquire autonomous mowers, two larger units for the soccer fields and two smaller units, which may be used at City Hall.
- Esplanade at Trinity Mills was completed and now we are coordinating to do walk throughs before opening to the public.

- Had our annual Ladybug Release, which was very successful, and the community really enjoyed it.
- Saturday, April 29 is the annual Carrollton Trails 5K race.
- May the 4<sup>th</sup> Be With You event. We had an organization reach out to us and they would like to bring new features and different activities.
- Summer Camp starts on May 30.
- Chalk Art Festival on May 20 at Mary Heads Carter Park.
- Paws on the Square coming up Saturday, June 27.
