The City of Carrollton has contracted Republic Services and CrowderGulf Disaster Recovery & Debris Management to conduct a special collection of storm debris at residential addresses starting Mon., June 3.



Residents are asked to place fencing and vegetative debris out **NOW through Mon.**, **June 10**. Early trash placement rules and regular/paid priority bulk pickup have been suspended.

PREPARE STORM DEBRIS FOR SPECIAL PICKUP

ALLOWED ITEMS FOR SPECIAL COLLECTION



Fencing material.



Vegetative debris such as tree branches, leaves, and twigs.



Bulk waste and regular trash* should **NOT** be included in this special collection.

*REGULAR TRASH/RECYCLING SHOULD BE PUT OUT ON RESIDENTS' NORMALLY SCHEDULED PICKUP DAY.

COLLECTION PLACEMENT



Items may be placed loosely or in a garden bag. Tree branches don't have to be bundled.



Storm debris should be set at the street curb in front of the home, not the alley. Do **NOT** park cars in front of the bulk items or mailboxes.

REGULAR WEEKLY BULK PICKUP

If debris is not placed by Mon., June 10, residents will still have the option of using the regular weekly bulk pickup after the special collection window. However, this might result in delayed pickup and require residents to cut and bundle debris that will not be required if it is set out for pickup by Mon., June 10. The final collection timeframe will depend upon volume and ease of access.
